VILLAGE OF WHEELER BURNING PERMIT

This permit is for open burning not in a fire ring with spark arrestor.

- 1.A As of 2/1/2024 Village Ordinance states fire will be 50 feet away from any.
- 1.B structure, wood or lumber pile, wooden fence, trees, or bushes/leaves needles. If the fire is in an approved incinerator (not burning barrel) distance is 15 feet.
- 1.C Not allowed to burn plastic, treated or laminated construction material, painted or stained wood, oil, tires, only clean wood is allowed to be burned.
- 1.D The size of the pile shall not be bigger than 4 feet in diameter and three feet tall.
- 1.E All fires must always be supervised by someone at least 16 years of age, with some form of extinguishing device nearby (garden hose fire extinguisher) Until all coals are out.
- 1.F No open burning on Holidays or Sundays.

Fire Department Burning Bans will always supersede this ordinance.

Fire Rings without spark arrestor (No Permit Needed)

As of 2/1/2024 Fire rings shall be no larger than 30 inches in diameter, no less than 6 inches above grade, made of stone, concrete, fire brick or steel.

Must follow 1.A, 1.B, 1.C, 1.E Wood can not be longer than 20."

Fire Ring with a Spark Arrestor

Outdoor Cooking (No Permit Needed)

Cooking can only be on ground level with approved cooking devices (gas grills, charcoal grills, electric grills. These cooking devices must be 15 feet from any combustible material.
