




I've bought a few of these over the years and i seem to get about 7-8 years of trouble free operation on average with typical maintenance, cleaning the coils every year and keeping the filters clean. This is the first one i've had that doesn't have a control panel on the unit itself, but instead a wireless wall-mounted thermostat. The set-up of the thermostat is easy enough and the directions in the user manual are good. The unit is noticeably quieter than the one it replaced.
